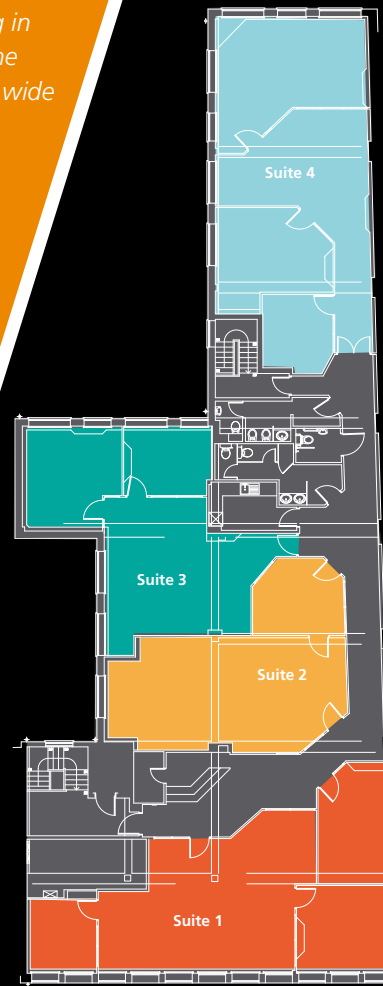

Flexible lease terms are available.

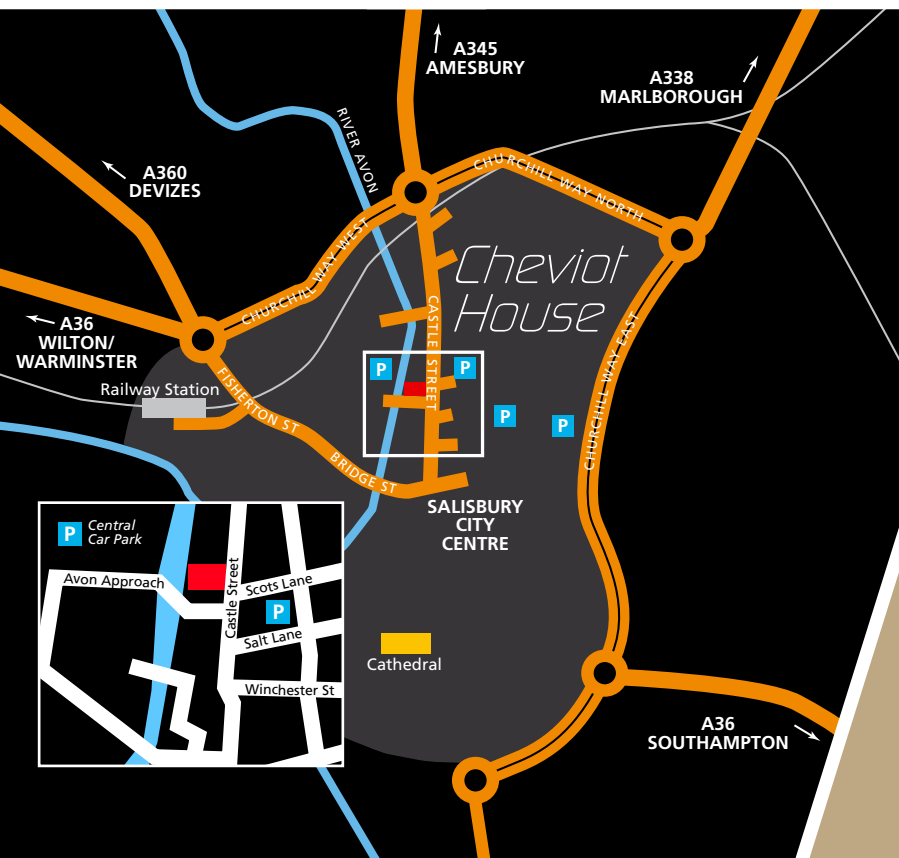
Second Floor Plan
